





Based on updated LCRA and WTCPUA requirements, the Hays WCIDs 1 & 2 Water Conservation and Drought Contingency Plans have been updated **effective May 1, 2024.**

Belterra is currently in **Stage 2** - once per week watering on designated day/time.

**Note:** While the stage titles have been adjusted to align better with LCRA and WTCPUA drought stages, landscape irrigation in Belterra remains limited to the once per week schedule.

The region's severe drought continues.

Conservation is essential to protect & extend water supplies.

Experts suggest our region could be in Stage 4 this summer, which would dictate NO outdoor watering. **We must ACT NOW to conserve.** 

## Current combined lake capacity - 42%

\*Failure to adopt, implement, and enforce the LCRA watering restrictions could subject WCID 1 & 2 to daily penalties of thousands of dollars <u>per day</u>.
