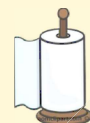

SCHOOL IS BACK IN SESSION



Students

- Make eye contact with drivers before crossing.
- Look both ways before crossing the designated intersections and crosswalks.

- Listen to the bus driver.

DRIVERS
