Notice is hereby given pursuant to Section 551 of the Texas Government Code, that the Board of Directors of Hays County Water Control and Improvement District No. 1 will conduct a special meeting at 4:00 p.m. on Wednesday, June 11, 2025 at Belterra Centre, 151 Trinity Hills Drive, Austin, Texas, for the purposes stated herein.

- 1. <u>Public Comment</u>: Hear public communications and comments (3 minutes per person; no action may be taken during public comment). If time permits, the Board by motion may reopen public comment after 5:00 PM to accommodate members of the public who are unable to arrive at the beginning of the meeting.
- 2. <u>Director Vacancy</u>: Review and approve of an Order Accepting Resignation of Douglas Botts and Appointing Walter Almon, confirm receipt of Statement of Officer forms and administer Oath of Office.
- 3. <u>Officers</u>: Elect Board officers and, if timely, reappoint committee members.
- 4. <u>Consent Items</u>: The following items are considered to be self-explanatory and may be approved by a single motion. There will be no separate discussion unless a Board member requests removal from the consent agenda.
 - (a) <u>Minutes</u>: Approval of the Minutes of the May 8, 2025 Regular Meeting, May 8, 2025 Special Meeting and the May 13, 2025 Special Meeting.
- 5. Landscaping Report:
 - (a) Report: Hear report from landscaper with respect to routine landscaping or additional landscaping projects in the District as may be proposed.
 - (b) <u>Action Items/Landscaping</u>: Discussion and possible action with respect to any landscaping matters that may come before the Board.
- 6. <u>Management and Operations Items</u>. Hear presentation of Operations Report and Manager's Report and consideration and possible action with respect to the following items:
 - (a) <u>Belterra Centre</u>: Update with respect to Belterra Centre repairs and upgrades.
 - (b) Drinking Water Quality Reports: Review annual drinking water quality reports.
 - (c) <u>Landscape Improvements</u>: Discussion and possible action regarding park and landscaping improvement projects including potential landscape master planning efforts with HCWCID No. 2.
 - (d) <u>Sunscape Amendment</u>: Discussion and possible action regarding proposed amendment to Irrigation Services Agreement with Sunscape Landscaping LLC to reflect change in Contracted Personnel from Arturo Hernandez to Mark Fischer.

- (i) <u>Action Items/Management and Operations</u>: Discussion and possible action with respect to any management and operations matters that may come before the Board including acceptance of the general management and operations reports.
- 7. <u>Engineering and Development Items</u>: Hear presentation of General District Engineering Report, and Joint Facilities Engineering Report, and consideration and possible action with respect to the following items:
 - (a) <u>Potential Water System Improvement Projects</u>: Update and possible action with respect to evaluation of potential water storage tank project and other potential improvements, including committee recommendations.
 - (b) <u>TXDOT US 290 Project</u>: Update and possible action regarding proposed US 290 expansion.
 - (c) <u>Pecan Park Pond</u>: Update and possible action regarding Pecan Park pond project, including without limitation review of bids and award of contract.
 - (d) <u>District Facilities</u>: Discussion and possible action with respect to recommendations related to design, improvement, repair, maintenance, use and acceptance of District systems, facilities and property, and such other engineering matters as are recommended for action.

- 8. <u>Financial Items</u>. Hear presentation of Financial Report and consideration and possible action with respect to the following items:
 - (a) <u>Administrative</u>: Administrative bookkeeping items, including opening and closing of accounts, approval of new signature cards and such other bookkeeping and financial items as are recommended for approval by the District's bookkeepers.
 - (b) <u>Approval of Accounting Report</u>: Approval of the Accounting Report, including, without limitation, monthly financials, cash activity report, budget items, and related disbursements, wires, and transfers.
 - (c) <u>Tax Exemptions</u>: Consider recommendation for tax exemption under Section 11.13(d) of the Texas Tax Code for individuals disabled or 65 and older and take any action necessary.

- (d) <u>Tax Exemptions</u>: Consider recommendation for tax exemption under Section 11.13(n) of the Texas Tax Code for all individuals based on percentage of the appraised value of residence homestead and take any action necessary.
- (e) <u>Tax Exemptions</u>: If necessary, in consideration of any actions taken with respect to the preceding items, approval and execution of new Order Adopting Residential Homestead Exemptions and authorization to file such Order with the Hays Central Appraisal District and the Hays County Tax Collector.
- (f) <u>Budget</u>: Discussion of preliminary budgetary matters for FYE September 30, 2026.
- (g) <u>Action Items/Financial</u>: Discussion and possible action with respect to any additional financial matters that may come before the Board.
- 9. <u>Administrative, Legal and New Business</u>. Consideration and possible action with respect to the following items:
 - (a) <u>WTCPUA</u>: Discussion and possible action with respect to procedures related to Boil Water Notices issued by the West Travis County Public Utility Agency.
 - (b) <u>Policy</u>: Discussion and possible action with respect to Aesthetics Style Policy as proposed by Joint Parks Committee.
 - (c) <u>Cybersecurity Training</u>: Discuss cybersecurity training requirements for the Board members to take annual cybersecurity training on or before August 15, 2025.
 - (d) <u>Interconnect Agreement</u>: Discussion and possible action with respect to proposed Interconnection Agreement with Hays County WCID No. 2.
 - (e) <u>Eminent Domain</u>: Update and possible action with respect to the use of eminent domain to condemn land in the Belterra subdivision required for water, sanitary sewer, treated effluent/reclaimed water, and/or drainage project improvements.
 - (f) <u>Membrane Warranty</u>: Update and possible action with respect to claim submitted to Kubota Corporation under warranty issued for submerged membrane units at wastewater treatment plant and any matters related thereto.
 - (g) Rate Study: Discussion and possible action regarding ongoing rate study by Expergy.
 - (h) <u>Consumption Data</u>: Discussion and possible action with respect to request from developer of Belterra Village regarding consumption data for commercial users.
 - (i) <u>Legal and Administrative Matters</u>: Discussion and possible action with respect to other legal and administrative matters that may come before the Board.
- 10. <u>Water Supply Agreements</u>. Consideration and possible action with respect to existing agreements for water supply with the Lower Colorado River Authority and water service through the West Travis County Public Utility Agency, water use under such agreements, water rates and fees charged to the District under such agreements, and other matters related to District water supply and conservation.
- 11. <u>District Calendar and Schedule</u>. Confirm dates for upcoming regular and special meetings, confirm dates for proposed committee meetings, discussion of upcoming events significant to District and/or Belterra community, and discussion of conferences, meetings and educational opportunities Directors' desire to attend.
- 12. Executive Session Regarding Item 9(d). The Board will recess into Executive Session to consult with its attorneys and receive information from its consulting engineer in connection with potential claims related to Item 9(d) above. The timing of this Executive Session will be dependent upon the arrival of the Board's consulting engineer.

- 13. <u>Executive Session</u>. The Board may recess into Executive Session at any time to consult with its attorneys regarding any posted matter for which the Board may seek the advice of its attorneys under Government Code 551.071 (including without limitation contemplated or potential litigation matters, and other legal matters related to agenda items) or for any action on the agenda for which a closed session is permitted by law, and will reconvene in open session for any appropriate action on any matter considered in Executive Session.
- 14. Adjournment of Regular Board Meeting.

Note on Executive Session: The Board of Directors will go into Executive Session, if necessary and appropriate, pursuant to the applicable section of subchapter D, Chapter 551, Texas Government Code Annotated, the Texas Open Meetings Act, on any matter that may come before the Board. No action, decision or vote on any subject or matter may be taken unless specifically listed on the agenda for this meeting.

Note on Public Comment: Any Person wishing to address the Board will be permitted to present comments at the time the presiding officer calls for public comments in accordance with the meeting notice.
